variety of contexts he argues one can gain a more enduring appreciation of the elements that affect peoples experiences in work and leisure pursuits a thorough review of the findings across this wide range of activities including his findings and ideas on hobbyists and career volunteers enabled stebbins to derive better definitions of the main concepts of the project such as amateur the public and serious leisure as well as professional where he distinguishes between client centred and public centred professionals who while sharing numerous ideal typical attributes vary as to the power and control they have over their work in a democratic society he presents inductive conclusions about careers and the costs and rewards in the eight amateur professional fields considered he examines the external world of amateurs and professionals in the light of such issues as family ties relations among amateurs and professionals and among amateurs and their employers public images critics and journalists community contributions and the question of marginality for amateurs who are caught between the work world of the professional and the casual leisure world of the majority of the population he concludes with an exploration of the future role of serious leisure in relation to predictions of greater unemployment and increased leisure time and longevity
